## Main duties and responsibilities

  yachts operating in the Pacific Asia area are compliant with necessary international and national
  requirements; including but not limited to, ensuring surveys are carried out and reviewed,
  certificates issued, resolving technical requests from clients and Agents; keeping yacht records upto-date.
- Work with MCI surveyors and approved ROs, to ensure that Cook Islands requirements are clearly
  understood and complied with, and that information is provided to MCI in a timely and accurate
  manner and in an easily understood and verifiable format.
- Work with the Technical Department team from time to time, to provide technical support clients.
- Become a proficient user and contributor to the Administrations IT systems and procedures.
- Report to the Head of Technical Department.
